On the 27 October 2024, the Eastern Cape Department of Sport, Recreation, Arts and Culture, together with Winnie Madikizela-Mandela Local Municipality, Alfred Nzo District Municipality, and the Department of Justice, honoured Sithembiso Stanford Madikizela's life and legacy.

Sthembiso Stanford Madikizela combat name Vusi Nxumalo was a loyal confidant, driver, and protector of Oliver Reginald Tambo. He was recruited by Oliver Tambo in the 1960s to join ANC in exile and he became a member of the Luthuli Detachment.

At Mbongweni village in ward 14, dignitaries gathered to pay tribute, including Amampondo King, MEC for DSRAC Honourable S. Ngongo, Alfred Nzo District Deputy Executive Mayor Cllr. Nomasoni Mshuqwana, Winnie Madikizela-Mandela Local Municipality Mayor Cllr. Daniswa Mafumbatha and Umkhonto weSizwe Liberation War Veterans EC Provincial chairperson Mr Mandilakhe Dilima.

MEC Sibulele Ngongo delivered eulogy, highlighting the National Cabinet's resolution to prioritize repatriation of remains of South Africans who fell outside the country during the struggle.

Winnie Madikizela-Mandela Local Municipality and Madikizela family chose OR Tambo Day on the 27 October 2024 to lay his remains to rest in recognition and acknowledgement of the association of the two heroes.
